

What to bring to your appointment

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PREPARE YOURSELF

The objective of the first appointment is to allow your adviser to clearly understand your current situation. This will enable an assessment of your circumstances to be made and a fixed cost of advice to be provided.

Investments	 □ Savings & Term Deposits □ Investment property details (estimated values and rental income) □ Investment/Managed Fund statements □ Share portfolio holdings
Debts	 ☐ Home loan statements ☐ Investment loan statements
Expenses	 ☐ Monthly expenditure amount (refer to the Moneysmart Budget Tool for assistance) ☐ One off expenses and when you expect these to occur (e.g. upgrade your car next year).
Insurance	☐ Policy schedules for Life Insurance, Income Protection, and Trauma Insurance policies
Identification	 □ Driver's license or passport for Australian identification laws regarding investments, insurance and superannuation □ Tax File Numbers
